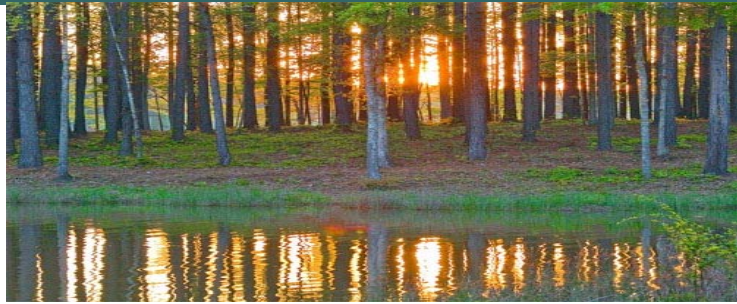


# Georgia Department of Transportation Scenic Byways Program



A Georgia Scenic Byway is defined as any designated highway, road, street or route, which features certain intrinsic qualities that should be protected or enhanced. It is these qualities, whether scenic, historic, natural, archaeological, cultural or recreational that give the byway its character and appeal.

Gaining the designation of a Scenic Byway can bring notoriety to a well deserving area in your community while also introducing tourists, recreational bicyclists, and other travelers to an area they may not have previously known.

To obtain designation as a scenic byway, a local sponsor must complete a multi-stage process of identifying a route, submitting an application, developing a Corridor Management Plan, and receiving approval from the Georgia Department of Transportation.
